

Unaccompanied Minors Policy Worldwide (Non-USA)



Some airlines have very strict policies regarding who they consider too young to fly alone. Most airlines provide an unaccompanied minors service for under 18s and the majority of them cater for 5 – 16 years olds. Ryanair an Easyjet DO NOT offer an unaccompanied minor service.

Each airline sets its own fees and regulations for unaccompanied minors, there are around 5000 airlines currently active and operational around the globe. It is therefore the parent or guardian's responsibility to check the unaccompanied minors section of airline's websites and to pay any additional fees associated with the child's travel. Some airlines charge more than £100 for this service.

In addition, PLUS will need to schedule a staff member to wait with them at the airport and then transfer that staff member back home, meaning an additional fee will be incurred on top of the airline fee.
