1 What is Integration?

Our Junior Integration Programmes provide international students with an authentic British educational experience by immersing them in the daily life of traditional boarding schools across the UK. Participants are integrated into existing classes alongside local English pupils, covering subjects such as geography and English history. Additionally, students have the opportunity to "buddy up" with teenagers, following their timetables and participating in day-to-day activities. This immersion allows students to enhance their English skills and gain firsthand insight into the UK school system.



2 Life at a UK boarding school

Most UK boarding schools welcome a blend of international and local UK students, creating a diverse social atmosphere where students from different cultures can learn from one another.

Students who live on campus are known as "boarders," while "day pupils" return home to their families at the end of each school day. Boarders live alongside their peers in shared halls of residence, creating a close-knit and unique community experience.

3 Accommodation

Accommodation is provided either within the boarding school or with carefully selected host families, giving students the option to experience British culture in different ways.

As a boarding student, you'll live in a shared hall of residence, giving you the chance to build close friendships with fellow students. With common areas for relaxing and studying together, this option provides students with a strong sense of community and belonging. From structured academic schedules to shared meals and evening activities, the boarding experience allows students to fully immerse themselves in British school life.

If you stay with a host family, you'll experience British culture up close in a comfortable home setting. Host families are carefully chosen to ensure a safe and welcoming environment where you can practise English daily, learn about local customs, and be a part of everyday family life. This option provides a unique perspective on British culture, offering a supportive home base while you enjoy your studies and activities.

4 Package Options

Our programme offers two flexible package options designed to suit different levels of English proficiency and personal preferences: Dual Integration and Total Integration.

Dual integration	Total Integration
Classroom plus English tuition for balanced learning	Full immersion in UK school schedule and curriculum
Best for students needing extra English support	Best for confident English speakers seeking deeper cultural immersion

Dual Integration: This option blends a traditional classroom experience with additional English tuition, which makes a perfect balance for many international students. Students spend part of their day in regular classes with local British pupils and the other part in specially designed English language classes. This structure allows students to both develop their English skills in a closed group and engage with British curriculum subjects, making it ideal for those who may need extra language support.

Total Integration: For students with a higher level of English proficiency, Total Integration offers а full immersion experience. Students attend classes entirely with British pupils, following a regular UK school schedule. They participate in all lessons, activities, and group projects, allowing them to experience British school life as fully integrated members of the community. This option is perfect for students looking for a deeper cultural and academic immersion.

Both options encourage students to participate in the social and academic life of a UK boarding school, helping them gain confidence in their English abilities and make lasting connections.

*Excursions: Both programmes include one excursion per week. Additional excursions can also be arranged on an add-on basis.



Frequently Asked Questions

• Who can participate — individuals or groups?

We welcome both individuals and groups. Some schools may be more suitable depending on the size of the group.

What about Group Leaders?

Group Leaders may be placed and may be expected for larger group bookings. Group Leaders are expected to supervise the students' welfare and help during activities and trips.

• What level of English should the students have?

English requirements vary by age, but generally, Intermediate is the minimum recommended level for a successful experience.

Are groups placed in the same class?

We aim to place your students in different classes alongside local pupils, with typically 1-3 students from your group in each class and grouped by age.

Do students need a uniform?

Students are not required to purchase the school uniform but should bring dark, business-style clothing. If students wear a uniform in their home country, they are encouraged to bring it instead.
